Literacy

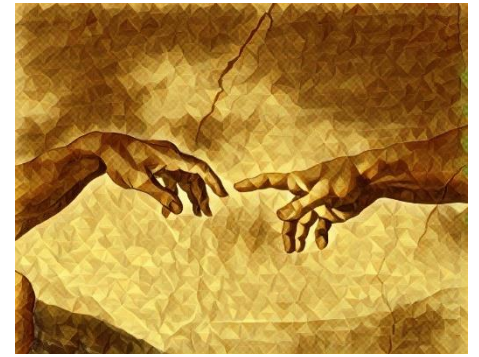
