Staff Update

Our heartfelt congratulations to Mrs Kirkman.

I am sure you will join me in congratulating Mrs Kirkman as she has informed the school that she is pregnant and will be taking maternity leave from April 2019. Although we are really delighted at this exciting news, we do understand that she will be a very hard act to follow – especially in the run up to the Year 6 SATs. I would just like to reassure all parents in Class 4 that recruitment processes are already underway to secure a high quality Yr 5/6 teacher during her absence, and we will be making sure that the children continue to get the best possible provision - both in the last few weeks of preparation, and throughout their tests. The class will be very well looked after.

There is no plan to recruit a replacement Head of School during Mrs Kirkman's absence. The intention is for Mrs Cox and Mr Pritchard (Head of School at Delabole) to continue to lead the two schools in order to sustain provision. Mrs Cox will amend her work schedule across the schools in order to ensure she is regularly available to staff, pupils and parents.
