Needless to say, this involves sometimes saying goodbye to staff as they move on, and having the opportunity to welcome new members of the team.



And now it is with some sadness that we find ourselves preparing to say a very fond farewell to Mrs Wilmott as she plans to relocate back to Bristol to take up a new post in September. Mrs Wilmott has been with us for a relatively short time, but during her time with us, she has become a very valued member of our school team and has helped us to develop singing across both Tintagel and Delabole. Our Christmas and Remembrance performances are clear evidence of this.
