Pre-historic	Can you draw a picture of your favourite dinosaur and write a label?
Fossil hunt	Can you go out in the garden and dig for fossils?

Traditional stories	Can you read your favourite traditional story in an unusual place and get an adult to take a picture?
Characters drawing	Can you draw a picture of your favourite traditional story character and write a label?
Puppet story telling?	Can you make a puppet and retell a familiar story?

Physical Development

Fine Motor	Can you teach a family member the handwriting sayings and write different phonemes?
Gross Motor	Swimming: can you as a family go swimming and build up your water confidence?
