Drama Group Performs at Falmouth University

On Wednesday evening, a dramatic ensemble formed from children across both schools and coached by Mrs. Murray and Ms. Thorpe, performed one of Shakespeare's most iconic speeches from 'A Midsummer Night's Dream' as part of the Royal Shakespeare Schools Festival. For the second year running, they performed alongside Secondary schools at Falmouth University. We are so proud to be one of only two primary schools represented in the project, and immensely proud that our talent for exceptional performance and high quality drama as a core element of our curriculum is being celebrated. Once again, our pupils demonstrated immense commitment and truly blossomed as part of the experience.

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Year 3 Trip To The Minack

Next week, on Monday we will be treating all our Year 3 children to a performance of Ali Baba and the Forty Thieves in the spectacular location of The Minack Theatre. We anticipate that your children will come home full of enthusiasm for the live performance set against the sea. It is a uniquely Cornish experience and an opportunity unlike any other.

Healthy Active Living Week - The Wonder of You

This event takes place in each school over the next two weeks and is linked to our Sports Day activities. As part of our commitment to shaping lifelong learning, under the umbrella of 'Mind, Body and Soul' we will explore a different focus on health and wellbeing each day ranging from healthy diets, to emotional wellbeing, outdoor creativity and culminating in our Sports Day. Please could you check the weather forecast for each day and prepare the children accordingly with either sun cream or their coats. They will need to have their PE kits in school all week. In addition to these important learning opportunities, children from Years 4 to 6 will be taking part in the SHEU Health and Wellbeing Survey. This is completed anonymously, and the responses are collated, and the data returned to school to give us a really clear picture of how our children feel about a range of issues such as managing friendships and remaining safe online. We will share the outcomes with parents later this term.

Sports Day Details 26th June

We would love to see as many parents as possible for our Sports Day on Wednesday 26th June. As with previous years, there will be a series of events across the full day and parents are welcome to join us at any point from 9:30am. Events will include our traditional dance competition to kick start the day and culminate with the more competitive, traditional track races in the afternoon on the field when we aim to start at 1.15pm and end with the awards ceremony at approximately 2.45pm. Children will be released from their classes at the normal end of day pick up time. In addition, we will be outdoors from around

9:30am and there will be a carousel of games and activities led by our pupil sports leaders. All children will participate in their House Teams and each station will be supported by an adult. We would like to invite parents to enjoy a picnic lunch on the field with their children before the afternoon track events. A special lunch can be ordered from the kitchen. Detailed information will be circulated on Monday but the menu is a small burger and chips at the cost of £2.20 per adult.

Surf Days at Polzeath

This annual event will take place on 28^{th} June for Classes 3 and 4. It is a celebration of our identity as a coastal school and an opportunity for the children to enjoy a day at the beach taking part in beach activities and surf lessons. There are also some really important messages about beach safety and respecting the water – so a memorable learning opportunity as well as being great fun.



Fly Up Days

These will take place on the 1st and 2nd of July when our Year 6 children who are going to Sir James Smiths will be at their new school. All other children will 'fly up' to their new year group and sample two days of learning. The new Early Years children are being given several opportunities to sample life in their new class over the next few weeks so they are ready and excited to move on. This year, as previously, there will be some year group splits because of our increasing numbers in order to even out the class sizes. The Senior Leadership team and the class teachers have been in discussion and will base their decisions both on progress and 'knowing' the child. For any parents that are affected by this, you will be contacted individually by letter and we will be giving you the opportunity to talk through the details with us prior to the Fly Up days.

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Class 4 Summer Performance

Class 4 are currently working hard on preparation for our production of A Midsummer Night's Dream and we are very much looking forward to their final performance of the year which will take place on Thursday 18th July at 1.30pm and 6.00pm for Tintagel School. I know the children will be so proud to share their talents with their families – so please do come and join us for a moving and memorable experience.



Leavers Assembly


On Wednesday 24th July they will say their final goodbyes at the leavers assembly from 2.00pm,
