COVID Updates

Whilst the government is easing restrictions for the general public, the updates to safe working procedures and educational providers guidance are minimal at this stage and are unlikely to significantly change this academic year. We continue to update our school risk assessment in order to adhere to all government recommendations for everyone's safety.

Whilst we appreciate that there seems to be a big contradiction in the activities that you can do at home, guidelines are in place to keep all our staff and children safe in school, reduce contacts and the potential for virus transmission and to allow the personal freedoms at home.

Can we please remind you that at present we still need to maintain social distancing at drop off and pick up and that we do continue to ask you to wear a face covering whilst on the school grounds.

In addition, any families planning to travel abroad over the half term holiday, please ensure that you are observing any quarantine measures. Anyone travelling to a country not on the government green list must quarantine for 10 days on return.

Last week many of our Year 4 and 5 pupils had a full day of activities down at Porthpean Outdoor Adventure Centre. This was because sadly the full residential couldn't take place with current restrictions in place. They had a fabulous day – despite the howling winds and persevered and conquered fears. We were very well looked after by the staff members on site and the children really enjoyed their experience.
